Who is it for?

The administrative permanence is intended for foreign people and the people who support them:

- **any foreign person**, with or without papers, who wishes to discuss, to be informed, or who is looking for solutions to his/her situation
- anyone in connection with foreign people : support, friend, host, etc.
- volunteers or employees of various **institutions**, **associations**, **groups** helping migrants.

What do we offer?

We offer **free administrative and legal assistance**, to the best of our abilities, with a human and friendly approach.

We can also be an **help for supporting people** : sharing information, discussing, or discharging them of certain of their responsibilities.

We do not offer food or material assistance, work or housing, but we can facilitate the **access to other resources**.

Examples of administrative help:

- obtaining and filling out forms (ex: application for CMU, transport, etc.)
- sharing contacts or information as needed
- helping with paperwork

Examples of juridical help:

- offering resources, documentation, contacts (about right of asylum, residence permits, appeal...)
- connecting with lawyers specialized in foreigners' rights and immigration laws

How does it work?

The permanence is a space designed to **take the time, together, to access information**, or to seek it. We are particularly keen to allow people to make choices for themselves.

We welcome users in two steps:

- a **friendly reception area** is offered to create a first contact,
- then, a space dedicated to individual interviews during which we guarantee the confidentiality of exchanges and information transmitted by users.

In those two **spaces, children are welcome**. If needed, people from the collective can take care of them in the first reception area while the parent is getting his/her individual interview.

For now, we do not get any specific translation or interpreting resources.

Where and when is it?

The 2nd and 4th Mondays of each month, from 4 pm to 7 pm, at the associative library « La Mauvaise Foix », 3 rue Mercadal, in Foix.
